

Share your lamb with your Neighbor

Exodus 12:3 Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

4 **And if the household be too little for the lamb**, let him and his **neighbour** next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.

Monday, August 4, 2008. My wife finished her morning Bible reading. I asked her what she has been reading. She smiled and said: God told Moses to tell the people they should share their Passover lamb if their household was small. Then she said God wants us to share the lamb with a capital L. You should write an article on that. I was inspired. I thought it was an excellent idea.

Our Passover Lamb is Jesus.

1 Corinthians 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. **For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:**

8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Ps 34:8 O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.

We are taught to share at a young age. As we get older and pursue success we lose some of our desire to share lest we have not enough. We forget ~ Luke 6:38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

We are too little for our Lamb. The first thing to look at is ~ Does our neighbor even have a lamb. Do they have the benefits of Calvary? Witness to them. Share your Lamb. He is the Prince of Peace. Everyone needs peace.

The Apostolic Cutting Edge started when Jesus ascended and put the future of His Church in the hands of the Apostles. It continues until this moment and is ever moving forward. We are in the flow. Opportunities arrive and we must recognize them or lose them. The key is Awareness.

Now back to my point. Does your neighbor even have a Lamb?

To witness you must get their attention with words. We are not an actor but an imitator of God.

2 Corinthians 5:20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: **we pray you in Christ's stead**, be ye reconciled to God.

We are the only Jesus they will see. The only voice they will hear. Because of the impression some have made they say ~ If yours is Christianity I want no part of it. Your love is not real.

Others say ~ I want to be like them. They are for real. I feel genuine love when I am around them.

Each of us will be in contact with people who will never hear the truth if we do not tell them. That is an awesome responsibility. First for now ~ and then to face in the Judgment.
