

How do you reason with God? You reason He is always right

Isaiah 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD.

In this verse of scripture God invites us to **reason** with Him. Reason with God in every scripture in this Newsletter. He invites us to present our reason and He presents His. Then a conclusion is reached. God is always right. We do not see that until we compare. Then we have reason to rejoice because we see His truth.

Stop ~ Reason with God ~ let Him help you to understand ~ He has all the answers.

As a Noun Stop means to arrest, check, halt, hitch, stay, stop, stoppage -- the state of inactivity following an interruption.

Stop means a period, point, full stop, stop, full point -- (a punctuation mark (.) placed at the end of a declarative sentence to indicate a full stop; "in England they call a period a stop")

Stop ~ Quit what you are doing ~ Make a change. Stop reasoning with your carnal knowledge. Reason with God.

As a Noun Reason means:

1. cause, reason, grounds -- (a justification for something existing or happening; "he had no cause to complain"; "they had good reason to rejoice")

2. reason -- (a fact that logically justifies some premise or conclusion; "there is reason to believe in God")

As a Verb reason means:

1. reason, reason out, conclude -- (decide by reasoning; draw or come to a conclusion; "We reasoned that it was cheaper to rent than to buy a house")

2. argue, reason -- (present reasons and arguments)

3. reason -- (think logically; "The children must learn to reason")

We have been endowed by our Creator with certain unalienable rights, one of which is **reasoning**. Study the Bible for good reasoning. We can reason out what is right ~ God is always right. We reason with God because He wants us to **see** His reason. We reason with God because He wants us to **understand** His Truth.

Psalms 73:22 **So foolish was I, and ignorant:** I was as a beast (no reasoning) before thee.

Psalms 73:28 **But it is good (reasoning) for me to draw near to God:** I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all thy works.

1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be **ready always** to give **an answer** to **every man** that asketh you a **reason** of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

16 Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, **they may be ashamed** that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.

Let us ~ you and me ~ reason together. Salvation is **not** an **unmerited** favor from God. ~ Ephesians 2:8. We are saved by Grace through faith. Notice "**through Faith**." ~ Hebrews 11:6. Without faith it is impossible to please God. ~ James 2:17 Faith without **works** is **dead** being alone. (Faith is the **work** of Grace we perform to receive Salvation. Grace without the **works of faith** is dead being alone.)

Reason with this Scripture ~ Acts 2:37 Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Reason with this Scripture ~ Acts 19:5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.
