

Be led by the spirit as you read this one. It is 95 percent scripture.

Jeremiah 6:15 Were they **ashamed** when they had committed abomination? **nay**, they were not at all ashamed, **neither could they blush**: therefore they shall fall among them that fall: at the time that I visit them they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.

16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But **they said**, We **will not** walk therein.

Overview of verb blush 1. blush, crimson, flush, redden -- (turn red, as if in embarrassment or shame; "The girl blushed when a young man whistled as she walked by") She turned red – she was embarrassed – she was ashamed – she didn't want to be that kind of a girl.

Mother ~ listen to me. God said: "they were not ashamed, **neither could they blush.**" This is a picture of today's world. **A 9 year old in church, dressed in shorts, bragged with a smile: "The boys are looking at me."**

1 Corinthians 6:15 Know ye not that **your bodies are the members of Christ**? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid.

16 What? know ye not that he which is joined **to an harlot is one body**? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh.

17 But **he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.**

18 **Flee fornication.** Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.

19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

20 For ye are bought with a price: **therefore glorify God in your body**, and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 Peter 1:13 Wherefore **gird up the loins of your mind**, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

14 As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the **former lusts in your ignorance**:

Hebrews 8:10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will **put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts**: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

Ephesians 5:3 But **fornication**, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints;

4 Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

5 For this ye know, that no **whoremonger**, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

1 Corinthians 5:9 I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with **fornicators**:

10 Yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with idolaters; for then must ye needs go out of the world.

11 But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.
