2. to lead a quiet life, 1 Thess 4:11 And that ye **study to be quiet**, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;

3. to be silent, i. e. to say nothing, hold one's peace: Luke 14:4 **And they held their peace**. And he took him, and healed him, and let him go;

James 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
