Mark 10:15 Verily I say unto you, whosoever will not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he will not enter in it.

To obey this scripture we must totally look to Him as our Father who is in control of our lives. We can do it because we formed a mind to do it. We know how to become as humble as a little child and still be as strong as a man.

In the beginning, God formed man from the dust of the ground, breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul (Genesis 2:7). God gave man a mind to match his soul. When the mind of man is turned loose in the kingdom of God, he can do great things for God.

The mind of man has the potential of Genesis 11:6 and nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do

Do you comprehend the feelings of faith God intended in that verse of scripture? Obey it clearly by meditating it into your soul.

All your mind needs is wisdom and knowledge and you can do what God has called you to do. Your imagination will become more than a fantasy world. **It will become your planning department.** Strong’s Hebrew Dictionary records the word “imagine” in Hebrew to mean: “to devise”; “purpose”; “think”. When you imagine, you “devise” things. When you imagine, you “purpose” to do things. When you imagine, you “think” pictures of things. When God formed man, He intended him to think on Godly things. Study Godly things and you will be approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed.

Man is equipped to do so much more than the things he does in the natural world. Man is a soul and can do things in the unseen world. Man is a “spirit being” housed in his own body with a mind to match his soul. He just needs to be taught how to think and what to think. This knowledge is found in the Bible. God has given us the Bible, the owner’s manual, teaching us how to think and what to think. Knowing what to think is the wisdom for learning.

Joshua knew what to think and boldly spoke to the sun saying, “Sun stand still,” and it obeyed him. Think about that! Think about what had to be in his mind for him to even attempt that. Think beyond that, because Joshua did. The sun was going down and the enemy could regroup its forces forming the battle harder for God’s people the next day. Joshua did not want a next day. He wanted the day to be extended so he could win today. The stopping of the sun was just a part of Joshua’s strategy. He was just giving an order to be obeyed. Think about Joshua’s mindset. He gave this order during the battle. He did it just like he would call up more troops. Friend, that is a mind that has learned God’s ways.

2 Corinthians 3:12 Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech.

Plainness of speech is important. We must be specific in what we ask. Faith is a clear substance of things hoped for. It is a clear evidence of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1). You can have the same faith.

2 Corinthians 4:13: “We having the same spirit of faith, it is written, I believed, and thus have I spoken; we also believe, and so speak.”

He can, with words, witness about Jesus and form a clear picture in the “mind of the soul” that will bring a person to a decision of giving his life to an unseen God “In whom we live, and move, and have our being.” This is all done in the unseen world.
