

Jesus is going to **make us look good** in the judgment.

God's plan for man from beginning to end is built around the Cross.

Jesus explained the cross in Luke 24:44-49. He explained **why He** ~ and **why we**.

Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:
47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

48 And ye are witnesses of these things.

If this was not so important we might get by ~ but ~ it is the **whole reason** for God's plan from beginning to end. The Cross is pre-told and post-told from eternity to eternity.

It is God showing His love for man in the greatest way possible. Greater love hath no man than this. **God desires to make us look good in the judgment.**

Out of **respect** for the Cross obey Jesus explanation from your heart. Without the Grace of God we **could not** obey Acts 2:38. Without **respect** for the Cross you will not obey Acts 2:38.

Knowledge is where it is. Knowledge will completely change your total view of things ~ your paradigm, your perspective, your position, your strategies, in fact all of you. Truth is hurt as much by silence as by falsehood.

Pay close attention. Grace has been corrupted. Grace Reigns for all who respect Jesus explanation for the cross in Luke 24:45-49. This is pure Grace in its highest form. God's Grace has been corrupted by many.

They make it what it is not. God's Grace is His willingness to withhold judgment giving us a chance to obey Acts 2:38.

Eph 2:4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,
5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in **the law of Moses**, and in **the prophets**, and in **the psalms**, **concerning me**.

1. The Tabernacle in the Wilderness is fulfilled in Luke 24:44-49.

2. The promises in the prophets are fulfilled in Luke 24:44-49.

3. The promises in the Psalms are fulfilled in Luke 24:44-49.

The Cross fulfills it all - proving God so loved the world.

It was the **Grace of God** that allowed Saul of Tarsus to make a choice.

Now pay close attention. Grace is given to those who respect Jesus **explanation** of the Cross in Luke 24:45-49. Grace is not a blanket thrown over a group. Grace is favor given to an individual.
