

**186 - The Oath of God - Jan 22, 2010**

The book of Luke and the book of Acts records the Oath of God ~ Surely I did it.

The Oath of God is when He repeats Himself. He gives the promise and because He can swear by no greater He swears by Himself, saying SURELY I WILL. He is the only one that has to give His own Oath because He is the Greatest.

Hebrews 6:13 For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he swore by himself, 14 Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.

15 And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

16 For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife.

17 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, **we** might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

19 Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

20 Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Melchisedec was a Priest without genealogy. Also there were no priest in my genealogy yet I am a priest unto God through the new birth.

God gave His Oath to Luke. When Luke found an eyewitness to what Jesus had done originally while He was on earth, God inspired Luke with the inspiration of His oath saying, "Surely I did that." Luke wrote with the inspiration of God's Oath. All scripture is given by the inspiration of God.

The Jesus of the Gospel of Luke is given to us by the oath of God. The Jesus of Matthew 28:19 is 100% correct. The book of Luke is God's oath that the words in Matthew are correct. The correct meaning is the NAME and not the titles Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Luke recorded God's oath. God's oath is, surely I did it. Luke wrote to Theophilus that these things were most surely believed among us Gentiles. The greatest need in the world today is the knowledge of Jesus that Luke recorded and preserved for us.

**Jesus makes the Whole Bible come alive.** Jesus is the Most High Far Above All Things. Far Above means in relation to a place that is higher. Jesus ascended far above all that is in the world to come. Jesus is not just a step or two up the ladder. Jesus is far above the top of Jacobs ladder. All things were made by Him and by Him all things consist. **The Godhead is understood by the things which are made. No excuse. Romans 1:20** For the **invisible things** of him from the creation of the world **are clearly seen**, being **understood by the things that are made**, even his eternal power **and Godhead**; so that **they are without excuse**:

**Ephesians 1:21** **Far above** all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

**Ephesians 4:10** He that descended is the same also that ascended up **far above** all heavens, that he might fill all things.)

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

2 The same was in the beginning with God.

3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

**Colossians 1:17** And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.
